



## VivekVahini

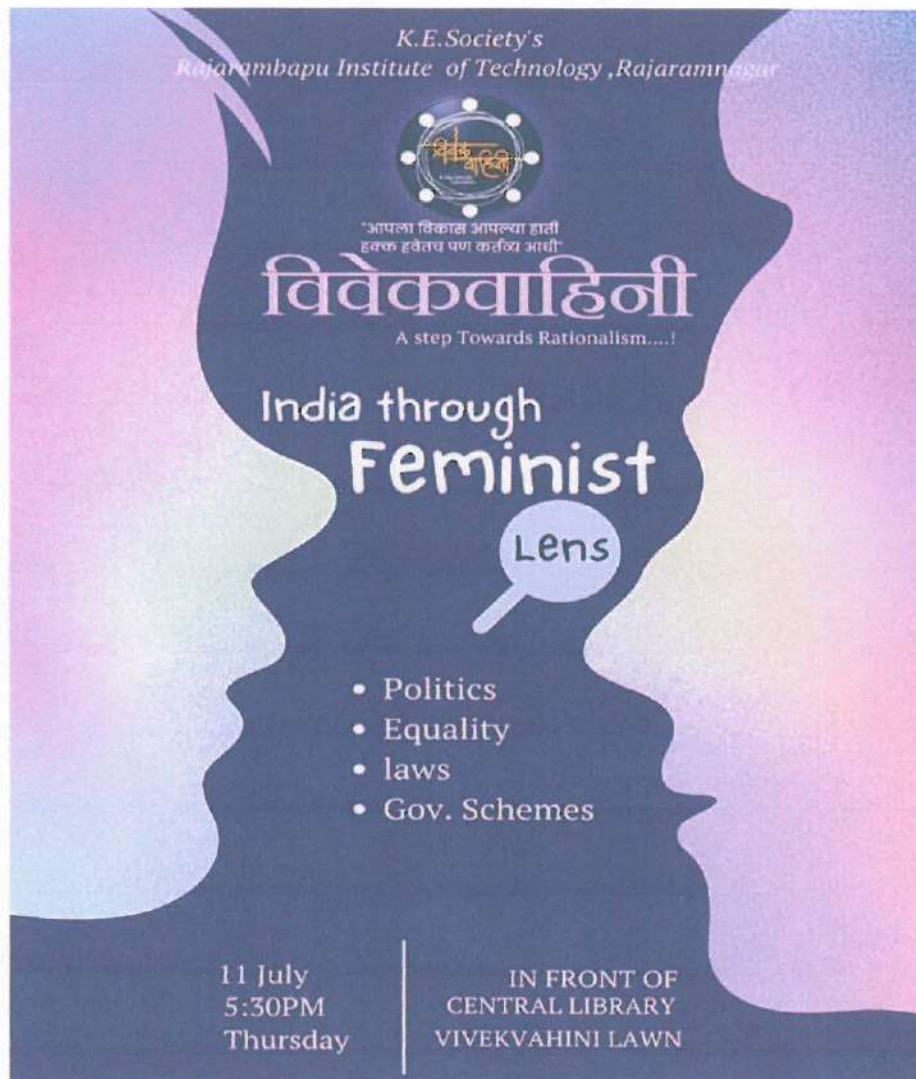

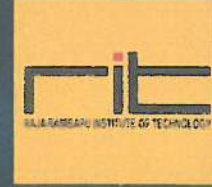
