R&D Policy

As per solution passed in BOG meeting (RIT/BOG/2012-2013/02 dated 19th March, 2013) wide Resolution No. 5.e it was resolved that approved R & D Rules & Policies are follows.

Proposed Research and development policy for faculty and students

1. **Patents: After Commercial (Final) Registration and granting of patent by IPO**
 - a) Potential for Commercial application : Rs.35, 000/- Per Patent
 - b) No commercial application : Rs.20, 000/- Per Patent
 - c) After commercialization of patent : will be decided upon case to case basis by R&D committee.
2. **Research Publication:**
 - a. **In National conferences for Faculty:**

Registration fees maximum up to Rs.5, 000/- and TA/DA shall be reimbursed as per Institute rules (Once in a calendar year).

If faculty member wants to attend second time in a calendar year then registration fees maximum up to Rs.2500/- and TA/DA shall be reimbursed as per Institute rules (once in a calendar year)
 - b. **In international conference for Faculty:**
 - i) **Within India:** Faculty member can attend such conference once in a calendar year, Registration fees maximum up to Rs.10,000/- and TA/DA will be paid as per Institute rules.
 - ii) **Outside India:** Faculty members can attend such conference once in a three year. Full registration fees and 50% Air Travel expenditure shall be reimbursed. DA will be paid as per UGC guidelines based on specific country visited only for the days of travelling to and fro and conference day(s).
 - c. **In National conference for M. Tech students:**

Students will be paid registration fees maximum up to Rs.2,000/- once in academic year for their paper presentation based on M. tech Dissertation work.

3. Research Assistantship:

Full time PhD. students: Rs.25, 000/- per month

4. Research Projects: Received research grant by Govt. or private Funding agencies

Under this scheme Principal Investigator will be eligible to get the incentive as per following categories of the projects.

Category	Project Categories based on Amount of Research Grant received	Incentive Amount (Rs.)
A	Research Grant up to Rs. 10.00Lakhs	7,000/-
B	Research Grant more than Rs. 10.00Lakhs and up to Rs. 25.00Lakhs	10,000/-
C	Research Grant more than Rs. 25.00Lakhs	12,000/-

- When more than one person is working on the project the incentive amount will be equally divided amongst the team member or can decided case to case basis.
- Out of the total incentive amount first payment (50% of incentive amount) will be made after the receipt of approval letter and the amount of grant in full or partial as per the agreement RIT and concerned funding agency. Balanced 50% amount will be paid only after successful completion of the said research project.

5. MODROB proposal sanctioned by AICTE:

The chief coordinator of the sanctioned proposal will be entitled to get the incentive amount of Rs.5, 000/-. Out of this Rs.2, 500/- will be paid after the receipt of sanctioning letter and the amount of grant by AICTE. Remaining amount of Rs.2, 500/- to be paid after successful installation and commissioning of the Laboratory equipment(s) and the receipt of amount of amount of first revenue generated using this faculty.

6) Student participation in special National/international level Competitions:

Based on collaborative recommendation of department HOD, Dean R & D & Director, the financial support from Rs. 50, 000/ to Rs.70,000/ will be sanctioned for Student's Participation in National/international level Competitions
