Minutes of Meeting

2. Prof. S. S. Kumbhar given background information of TDC Cell. CTARA, IIT Bombay is working on society related projects along with various government agencies from 2007. The outcome of these projects alongwith need and demand analysis of similar projects in the different regions of Maharashtra, Gov. of MH came with GR on society related projects.
3. Dr. S. S. Kulkarni, Dr. P. S. patil and Prof. S. S. kumbhar attended a meeting organized by SPFU regarding TEQIP-II Review Meeting of project institutes & उन्नत महाराष्ट्र अभियान On 7th June 2016 in ICT Mumbai, proposed TDC cell at institute level to get government data and funding for projects by DPDC.
4. Prof. S. S. Kumbhar given a presentation on various ongoing projects and discussion was done on various societies related issues.

5. Dr. P S Patil, suggested sectors of projects with involvement of faculties in project at ground level for implementation and assessment purpose.
6. Dr. A. C. Attar, suggested “Gotkhindi” village for adoption by RIT and its complete development plan with due considering all department credentials. It was decided to invite Key person (Sarpanch/ Gram sevak) from Gotkhindi for further discussion.
7. Prof. R. T. Patil, suggested “Jakraiwadi” irrigation scheme for improvement purpose.
8. Prof. D. S. Patil raised issue of data management and administrative system for government body.
9. Dr. A. B. Kakde, interacted with municipal corporation Islampur for issues in drinking water management and its related issues. It was decided that, TDC cell member will interact with municipal corporation of Islampur for further solution.
